

Covid 19 Preparation:Mandatory Practices for Glaziers

DO

DO wash your hands with soap and water often. Use alcohol-based hand sanitizer WITH frequent handwashing, NOT in place of frequent hand washing EXCEPT when handwashing is not possible.

DO throw used tissues and paper towels in the trash immediately after use.

DO throw away your own trash. Keep your tools, trash, and other materials picked up and put away. Disinfect all surfaces as often as possible.

DO stay at least 6 feet away from everyone else. If you are working in baskets, use every precaution possible. Wash your hands thoroughly as soon as possible.

DO wash your hands thoroughly BEFORE and AFTER eating.

DO keep your hands away from your face.

DO NOT

DO NOT go to work if you have a temperature higher than 98.6. Check your temperature every morning BEFORE going to work. If you do have a temperature higher than 98.6, contact managers by phone immediately. **DO NOT** return to work until you have been fever-free for 24 consecutive hours.

DO NOT share tools, cell phones, desks, offices or other belongings. Keep your tools and belongings separate from others'. If sharing is unavoidable, wipe the points of contact with a sanitizing wipe.

DO NOT go to work sick, and **DO NOT** stay at work sick. If you think you may be sick, let managers know immediately, and go home. Symptoms include fever, cough, and shortness of breath.

DO NOT cough or sneeze into your hands. When you cough or sneeze, cover your mouth and nose with a tissue. If you do not have a tissue, cough or sneeze into the sleeve of your shirt.

DO NOT enter an area containing more than 10 people.

DO NOT shake hands or touch surfaces that may have been touched by someone else.
